**JOHN KRUMM** is a renowned and well-loved dance/music magician. He has been calling and playing for dances for over 28 years. He performs at festivals such as Ashokan and Pinewoods. He has published a book of rounds, partner songs, and original compositions.

Lead by two of Canada's leading traditional musicians, **Julie Schryer** on piano and **Pat O'Gorman** on flute and pipes, the group plays a wide range of styles including Canadian, Irish and Scottish, for contra dances. Rock solid on the fiddle is **Benoit Schryer**, whose steady groove is the result of being immersed in traditional music all his life. **Zach Schryer** rounds out the group playing whistle, cello and guitar. Once you've danced to this band, you'll rave about the O'Schraves!

**KATE MCLAREN** is an engaging caller and personality, who performs at dances and social occasions in Grey- Bruce and beyond.

**SCATTER THE CATS** - Will Henry, Dan McGee, Mark Cruikshank and Frank Francalanza have for 20 years anchored music for the Grey-Bruce contra dance community, beginning with the Glenelg Full Moon Country Dance Band. Now with the addition of Randy Martin on bass and percussion, these musicians offer an eclectic mix of original dance tunes, influenced by Irish, Appalachian old Canadian dance repertoire and traditions, played on a long list of stringed, bowed and blown instruments, and things to beat on.
